The Children Of Africa has opened a a family. shelter for orphaned, abandoned children in order to provide them with a family environment.

The children's shelter, la Case des enfants is located in the heart of Abidian in the district of Plateau. For 20 years now the shelter has been receiving children (girls and boys), orphans, abandoned children, street children, or children from poor families, without ethnic or religious consideration.

The shelter also provides food, accomodation, supervision, education, training and healthcare to the residents. Its main objective is to restore dignity to those children who have experienced hardship life from an early age, by giving them the opportunity to reintegrate the society and






At the initiative of a group of friends who wanted to help street children, La Case des Enfants opened its doors in 1994 in Abidjan . It has been taken over since 1998 by the Children of Africa Foundation chaired by Mrs Dominique Ouattara, who is the current First Lady of Côte d'Ivoire since 2011.

ABOUT US

The shelter takes care of street children, orphans, abandoned and poor children or children engaged into exploitation aged 6 to 18 years. Since 2009, the shelter has started receiving young girls instead of boys only as previously.

With a capacity of 60 beds, the center offers to children the opportunity to go to school and open their minds to art, computer science, sports etc through a range of activities that are being organized. In addition, psychological support through listening session is provided to help the children gain confidence and appreciate life again. One of its objectives is to also ensure that children are reintegrated into their family. In view of that, the shelter has put in place a three year follow-up program to consolidate children's reintegration. This social and academic support gives them the tools to move towards a better future.

OUR MANAGEMENT TEAM

It's a permanent team of 10 people who supervises the children 24 hours a day and 7 days a week. The management team is composed of a director, specialized educators, a social worker, cooks, guards and a pediatrician who comes regularly for check ups. We also receive support from many volunteers on a regular basis and from the sisters of the congregation of Our Ladv of Peace.

Efforts are being made to ensure that every child attends school nearby. They are also monitored after school by educators who ensure that their schooling takes place in the best conditions and that the children have been diligently following each course.

> In addition, the Children's Shelter has an important vocational training and apprenticeship programme that aims to provide children with a job once they leave the Shelter. These are sewing and market gardening programme and computer training.

REGULAR FOLLOW UP OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SITUATION

Children are also provided with a free healthcare service at the children's Hospital in Bingerville. They are subject to medical checks and vaccinations.


