For the 2017-2018 school year, more than a dozen school libraries have received books from Mrs. Dominique Ouattara's Foundation. These are the libraries of the High School of Mankono, the High School of Bouaké, the High School of Grand-Bassam, the Sainte Marie High School of Cocody, the Bassa School Group in Bouaké, the High School of Angré, the High School of Daloa and the library of Treichville.

MOBILE LIBRARIES TRAVEL ACROSS CÔTE D'IVOIRE

The Children of Africa's mobile libraries crisscross the country's towns and villages to promote books and reading among primary and secondary schools children. The localities of Ouragahio, Dabakala, Daoukro, M'Bahiakro, Kong, Korhogo and Vavoua welcomed with joy and fervor the presence of the Bibliobus. The three months spent in each of these localities allowed the children to become familiar with books and discover the joy of reading. The larger Bibliobus was made available to the District of Abidjan, and participated in a Musical Festival (FEMUA 2017) in Marcory Anoumabo which took place from 25 to 28 April 2017 and in the Book Fair of Abidjan held from 24 to 28 May 2017.

DISTRIBUTION OF 15,000 SCHOOL KITS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2017-2018

For the school year 2017-2018, Children of Africa Foundation has launched the distribution campaign of 15,000 school kits to schoolchildren in all regions of Côte d'Ivoire. The starter of this caravan to support schooling and education, was given by Mrs. Dominique Ouattara, President of Children Of Africa, on Monday, October 2, 2017, at the School Group of Abadjin-Kouté, Songon village, in the presence of Mrs. Clarisse Duncan, wife of the Vice-president, Mrs. Kandia Camara, Minister of National and Technical Education, Minister Robert Beugré Mambé, Governor of the Autonomous District of Abidjan and native of Songon and many other officials. Thus, for this new school year, 15,000 school kits, made up of books and school bags were offered to school children from all regions of the country.







A CANTEEN AND SCHOOL KITS OFFERED TO CHILDREN IN PONVOGO

Children of Africa Foundation has donated school kits to more than 300 children in Ponvogo, a village located a few kilometers from the city of Korhogo. The donation ceremony was held in the community on Tuesday, November 8, 2017.

The new canteen in Ponvogo has been fully equipped and was provided a cookware set including a freezer, two gas burners connected to two gas cylinders, to offer new catering conditions to the 136 students. In addition, 2.5 tons of rice, pasta, ten cans of 20 liters of oil, tomato paste, etc. were given for the canteen.

The First Ladies were able to discover a beautiful level 3 hospital under construction. For the occasion, Mrs. Dominique Ouattara, President of Children of Africa Foundation explained to her sisters the deep reasons why she has undertaken this major project.



123 beds and a technical platform of last generation will be available. The hospital will open its doors in March 2018.

CONSTRUCTION OF A HOUSE OF LIFE BY LALLA SALMA FOUNDATION



The President of Children of Africa had a meeting with a delegation from the Foundation of Her Royal Highness Lalla SALMA, wife of the King of Morocco, on February 21, 2017 at the main office of the foundation, in cocody, for the construction of a home to receive children with cancer and their families at the Bingerville Mother and Child's Hospital. This home will support the MCH Children's Pediatric Oncology Center and will include about 20 rooms, an administration, a treatment area and a play area for children.

VISIT TO « THE HOUSE OF LIFE » OF FES



As part of the construction by her Royal Highness, Princess Lalla SALMA, of a «house of life» for cancer patients within the Mother-Child's Hospital of Bingerville, the President-Founder of Children Of Africa visited «the house of life» of Fez on May 11, 2017, located in the CHU Hassan II of Fez, and this, together with Mrs. Ilham JAMAI Foundation Lalla SALMA. On this occasion, Professor Ait Taleb KHALID, General Director of Chu Hassan II of Fes, presented to Mrs. Dominique OUATTARA, President and Founder of Children Of Africa, this temporary and pleasant accommodation space, designed to encourage patients to continue their treatment.

FREE CARE TREATMENT TO 20,814 CHILDREN AND 1,029 EYEWEAR GLASSES OFFERED DURING THE 5TH OPHTHALMIC CARAVAN



After its launch at Marcory-Anoumabo on April 7th, 2017, at Groupe Scolaire d'Anoumabo, the 5th free ophthalmic consultation caravan initiated by Children of Africa Foundation set sail for the Haut-Sassandra region. Indeed, from 22 to 29 April 2017 the caravan has crisscrossed the localities of Issia, Saïoua, Vavoua, Zoukougbeu and Daloa.



During these consultations, 20,814 children received free treatment from Children of Africa's ophthalmologists. Taking advantage of this opportunity, these children whose age is between 0 and 15 years, have also benefited from a systematic deworming when 1,029 children received free pairs of glasses. The local authorities headed by the President of the Regional Council of Haut-Sassandra, Prof. Alphonse Djédjé Mady thanked the First Lady who initiated the project.

The communities, for their part, showed their gratitude to Mrs. Dominique Ouattara through their exceptional participation.

A HUMANITARIAN MISSION TO SAVE CHILDREN SUFFERING FROM HEART DISEASE

AFCAO, CHILDREN OF AFRICA FOUNDATION AND ABIDJAN INSTITUTE OF CARDIOLOGY GIVE HOPE TO SICK CHILDREN

The French Heart Association for West Africa (AFCAO) in collaboration with Children of Africa Foundation of Mrs. Dominique OUATTARA and the Abidjan Heart Institute (ICA) has launched a humanitarian heart surgery mission for children between 6 months and 16 years old, on May 12, 2017, at Children of Africa Foundation's headquarters in Cocody. From May 13 to 19, 2017, specialists in congenital heart disease with surgeons of the Abidjan Heart Institute were able to operate and treat 23 children and 2



sick adults free of charge. The surgery was successful thanks to the medical teams mobilized by Professor Mohamed Ly, cardiac surgeon and President of AFCAO.

After receiving in audience at her residence, on May 17, 2017, the AFCAO team led by its President, Professor Mohamed Ly, Mrs Dominique OUATTARA, President of Children Of Africa, paid a visit on May 18, 2017 to the children who successfully went through the surgical intervention, at the Abidjan Heart Institute.

She took the opportunity to inquire about the children's health status and offered them some gifts. We could see joy on the face of these kids.



MERCK SUPPORTS CHILDREN OF AFRICA FOUNDATION

As part of the construction of the Mother-Child's Hospital of Bingerville, the German firm made a donation of 350,000 euros or more than 200 million CFA francs to Children of Africa Foundation on July 20, 2017.

DONATIONS TO THE HEALTH CENTER OF THE REGIONAL ACADEMY OF MARINE SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (ARSTM)



The President and Founder of Children Of Africa, Mrs. Dominique OUATTARA presided the festivities marking the 30th anniversary of the Regional Academy of Marine Sciences and Technologies (ARSTM), on Wednesday 2 August 2017, at the Regional Maritime Training Institution.

In this context, the President and Founder of Children Of Africa donated 1,000 doses of typhoid fever vaccines, a medical ambulance, and equipment to the Health Center of the Regional Academy of Marine Sciences and Technologies (ARSTM) of the 15 francophone countries of West and Central Africa.

ALERE DONATES 5 POINTS OF CARE TO THE FOUNDATION

ALERE has donated 5 devices points of care to help Mrs Dominique OUATTRA achieve her mission as UNAIDS Ambassador for the elimination of mother-to-child transmission and the promotion of pediatric AIDS treatment. These devices allow early diagnosis of HIV / AIDS in children born to infected mothers. The diagnosis enables immediate treatment in order to reduce HIV / AIDS related deaths in young children.

Located in Soubré, this center will be inaugurated very soon. The next two to be built in the cities of Ferkéssédougou and Bouaké, will be carried out in the course of 2018. These reception centers will significantly improve the protection of children involved into exploitation, trafficking and child labour in the most at-risk areas of Côte d'Ivoire.

HELPING CHILDREN WITH AUTISM

Children of Africa Foundation has given its support to the World Autism Awareness Day 2017. Indeed, the Foundation of Mrs. Dominique OUATTARA has provided financial assistance worth 3 million CFA francs at the Center for Medical and Psychosocial Action (CAMPS), on March 30, 2017, at the Foundation's headquarters in Cocody.

Social Samu in Senegal



In 2017 Children of Africa Foundation renewed its support to Samu Social Senegal, which helps street children in Dakar and aims to improve the situation of children at risk living on the street and to avoid further degradation of their conditions. It seeks to establish a procedure to care for children at risk and anyone excluded from the traditional care mechanisms.

Pilot Village in Senegal



Since January 2017, the Pilot Village has implemented different activities :

• 115 interviews were made in the streets of Dakar. About 300 new young people were identified.

- 221 children were provided assistance
- 30 family reintegrations
- 96 young people were able to benefit from the services of a vocational training center

Arc en Ciel in Gabon

on June 16, 2017, the Arc en Ciel Association organized the day of the African child at the complex social Benoit MESSIANI. The aim was to give children time to express themselves through a play about their experiences. They were able to freely express their potential through games and dance.

Social Samu in Burkina Faso



The Samu social Burkina Faso had the honor of welcoming Aude MASSOT, an author and comic book designer, to its emergency center with nursing and psychological care, who quickly conquered the hearts of street children hosted in the center by creating a link with them.

Arc en ciel Center in Odienné

Opened in 2011 in Odienné by the Sisters of the Holy Family of Spoleto, the Arc-en-Ciel center is a recognised nursery that welcomes full-time fifteen orphaned, abandoned and vulnerable children between 0 and 5 years old. This house is a place of life where everyone's fulfillment is a priority.



SAPE CI

Sape CI provides psychosocial care to (street children, unaccompanied children, children in social difficulty ...), provides medical care, provide assistance to victims of sexual violence, provides socio-educational care, school care and social integration.



St. Mary Clinic

In 2017, the nuns' clinic in Bondoukou provided follow-up and assistance to children infected with HIV. The clinic provides school assistance, clothing, food and medical treatment to children, nutritional care for orphans. They also contributed to the building of benches and the purchase of cradles for motherhood.
